Technical Requirements

Audience maximum: 300

Performing space: min. 1.5 meters width x 2.5 meters height X 2 meters depth

Set up time: approx. 1 hour

Dismantling time: approx. 30 minutes

Staff on tour: 1 person

Baggage: 1 extra standard flight bag

Sound: Equipment (neck microphone, speakers, control with a connection to an mp3 player) should be supplied.

Light: Basic Lightning (only if played on night time or indoor)



About the creator

Ariel is a Puppeteer and Director.

He performs in festivals and theatres worldwide with his puppetry & object theatre shows, most recently "Plastic Heroes", object theatre show for adults about war using children's toys.

He also animates puppets in many television shows and films, uses as artistic advisor and gives workshops on puppetry for television.
